Your assigned spot(s) and parking options will be marked on the venue map which will be e-mailed to you the week prior to the event. Some volunteers will be available to assist in the set up and parking. On street parking is not allowed as valuable parking on the street is reserved for buyers and visitors! Please do not block crosswalks OR doorways at ANY time. **You are expected to stay open for business until 4 p.m.**

Applications must be received by July 1 for your name and booth location to be included in the show's program.

Submission & Exhibit Requirements: Images must be submitted via email or regular mail for consideration with the vendor application. A registration form must be submitted with fee paid. (See below)

The work represented must be primarily created by the exhibitor. The work(s) must be creatively modified by the exhibitor into its present state. All work is displayed in a neat and professional manner.

Awards: Awards will be given to outstanding work in Arts/Crafts and Industry/Science. Ribbons will be awarded for 1st, 2nd 3rd and Honorable Mention. If you would like to participate in awards, you need to pick up required information at the check-in booth on the morning of the show. Awards will be judged by regional arts and industry professionals, in-booth. Judges may or may not choose to interact with exhibitors.

Check in & Set up: 6 AM to 8:45 AM. Complimentary coffee will be available and some volunteers will be on hand to help with set up. Vehicles must be parked and your booth must be open for business by 9 AM. Exhibitors and vendors must stay for the duration of the event, rain or shine and must come prepared for all weather including preparing booth with anchoring systems in the case of strong winds.

Insurance & Taxes: Vendors and exhibitors are responsible for their own liability insurance. Food vendors must provide proof of insurance with application. Vendors and exhibitors are responsible for claiming all applicable taxes.

Rain Date: Show organizers have added a rain date in an effort to ensure booth holders have an opportunity to make their investment back. The rain date will be the following Sunday, July 29. All check-in procedures remain as previously described.

Refunds: Refunds will ONLY be granted BEFORE July 1. There are absolutely NO refunds after July 1 for any reason, as facilities, insurance, administration, etc, have already been paid regardless of if the show is delayed or canceled due to rain. Refunds issued prior to July 1 will be subject to a \$5 fee.

Booth Assignments:

All booths are easy access for unloading/loading. Please include a note with your application if you have special parking or bathroom needs.

Booth choices are given to previous exhibitors. We will do our best to assign the best possible spot for all exhibitors. We reserve the right to change the booth assignment at any time for the ultimate benefit of the show and all exhibitors.

CONFIRMATION

You will receive an acceptance email shortly after sending our application. Detailed information about artist awards, venue map, food vendors, parking, directions will be provided by email one week prior to the event.

In an effort to Go Green, you will receive your confirmation by E-MAIL ONLY unless you specify on your application that you need yours sent by regular mail.

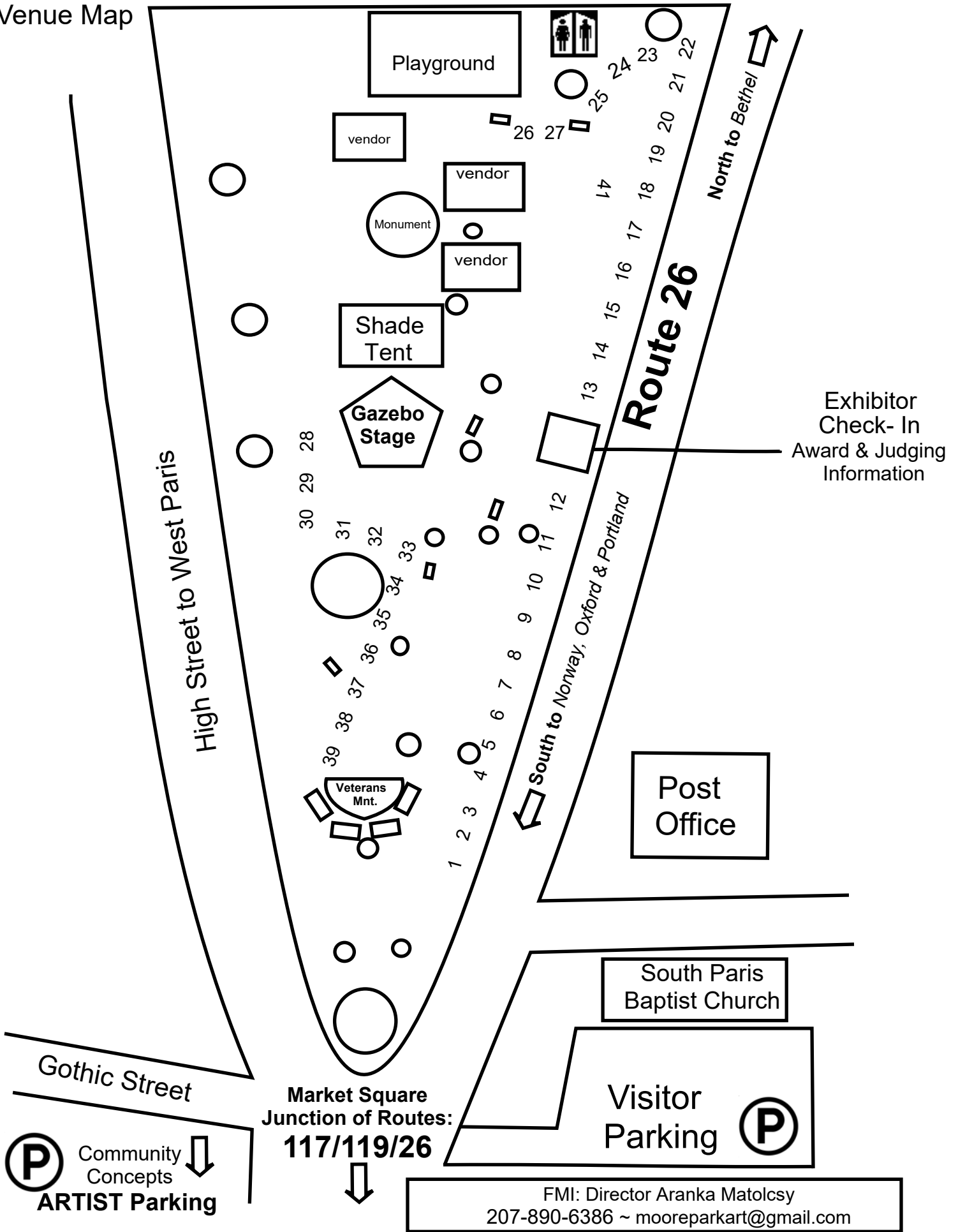
